We **use the suffix -ful to make adjectives**, but watch out – although the word ‘full’ has been put on the end of ‘hope’, the last l is dropped.

Can you complete this table to show how words are changed by adding the suffix -ful?

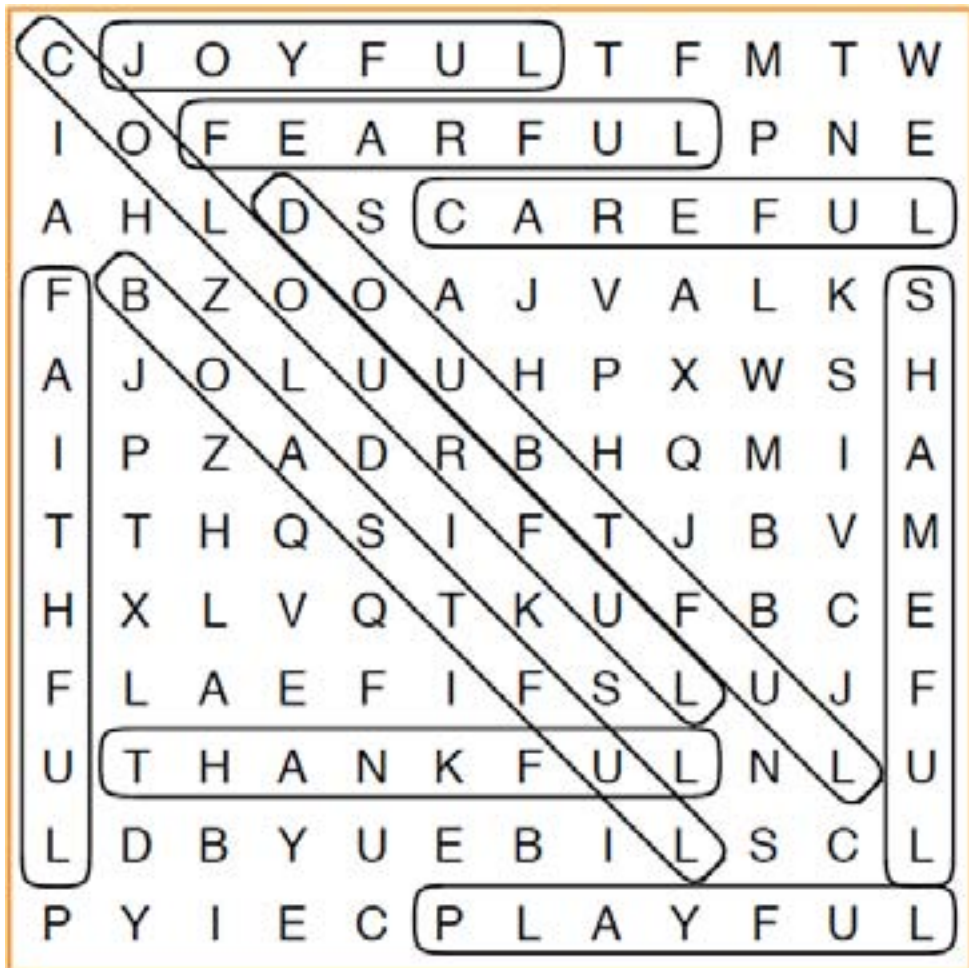
