Week commencing 23rd March we will be holding parents evenings. This means there will be no after school clubs other than Wraparound Care that week.

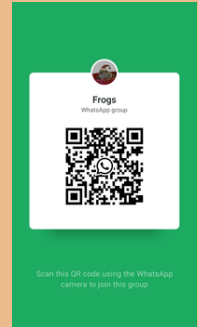
