## PARENT GOVERNOR MEETING CHANGE OF DATE

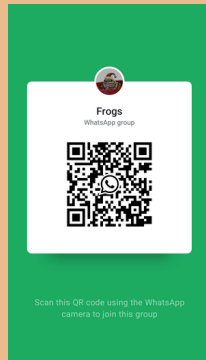
The next parent governor meeting will now be Monday 17th November at 2.30 pm instead of Wednesday 19th

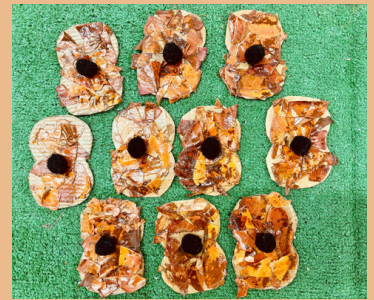

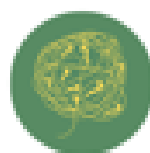

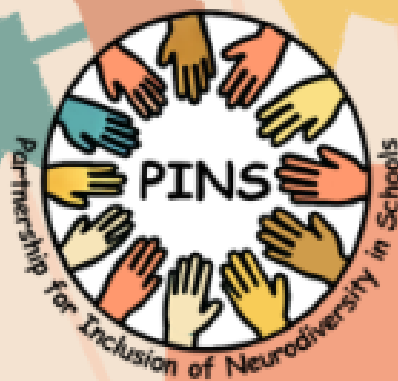
